

Tobias Caraker

Born 14 Jan 1833 Jonesboro, Illinois Died 17 August 1915 Moreland, Scott County, Missouri

Married to Sarah Jane Haire (Hare)

Son of Jacob Caraker (Served in War of 1812) and Phoebe Verble of Cabarrus NC

Grandson of
Andrew and Christine Carriker (Orginally Karcher)
who supported the
Revolutionary War
and whose brother, George (Karcher) Karaker
and father, Johann Philip Karcher (Kerker) were soldiers.

Brother to Henry and Samuel Caraker who served by his side in the 109 and 11 Illinois Infantry. Also, brother to Elijah Caraker who served in the 31 Illinois Infantry Company E and James M. Caraker who was in the 6 Illinois US Calvary, Company M.

Trivate Tobias Caraker

109th Illinois Infantry, Company C

transferred to 11th Illinois Infantry Company A. They were in the battle of Vicksburg and aided General Grant in several battles.
